CRISIS RESPONSE TEAM

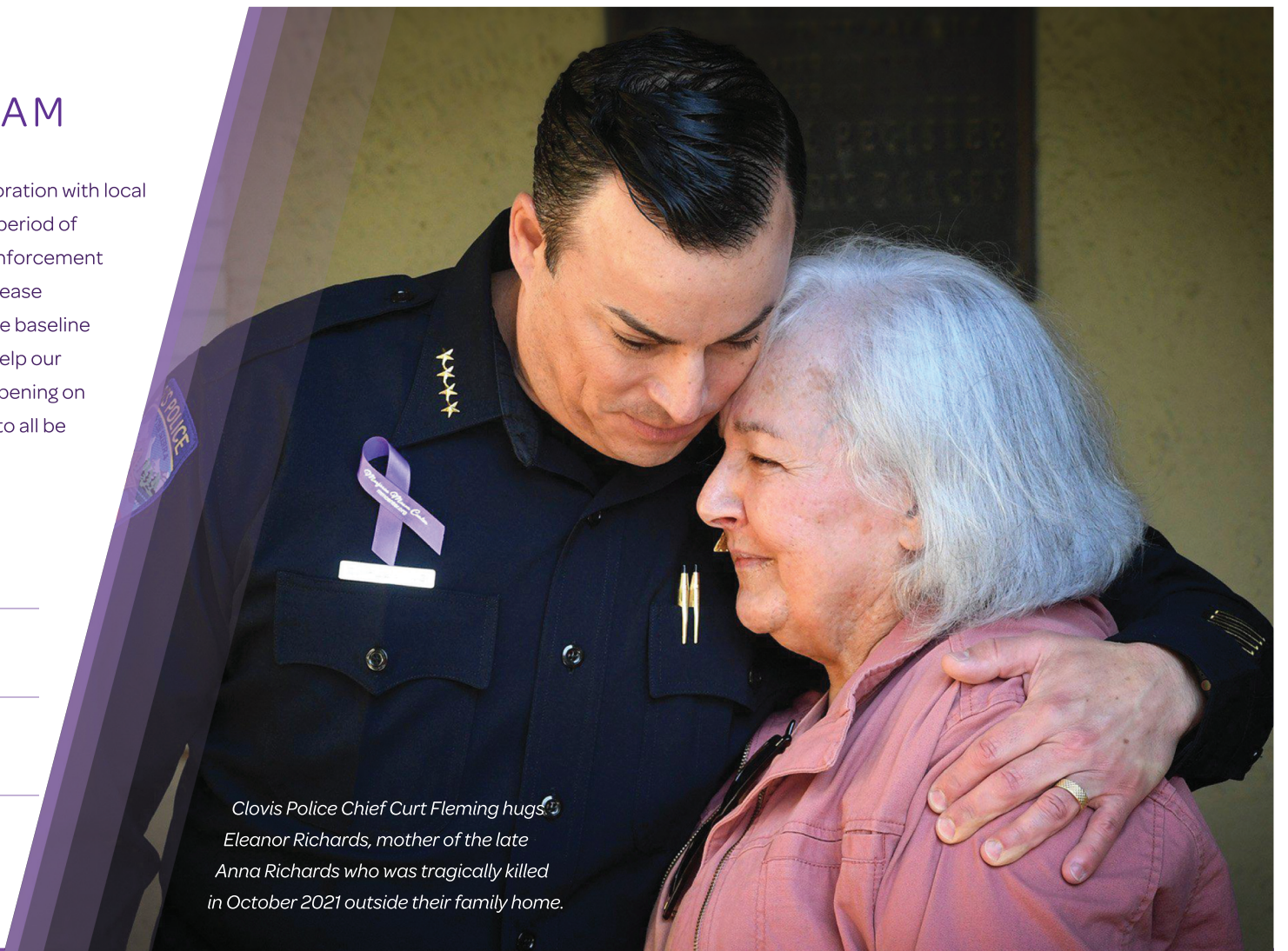
In the 2021-2022 fiscal year, we saw increased collaboration with local law enforcement agencies. Following an unfortunate period of back-to-back domestic violence fueled deaths, law enforcement leaders partnered with Marjaree Mason Center to increase countywide response. This collaboration served as the baseline for share work to streamline data collection that will help our entire County have a better pulse on what is truly happening on domestic violence calls. This shared work will help us to all be more strategic and focused in our prevention work.

A MESSAGE FROM THE CEO

In 1978, Marjaree Mason was tragically murdered by someone who claimed to love her. Today, the Marjaree Mason Center offers critical resources for both emergency and long-term needs of both those who are adult and child survivors of domestic violence, but also those who have caused harm. It takes a tremendous amount of courage for a person to push through fear in order to seek physical and emotional safety.

This past year, we have invested more resources in prevention as we continue to address the root causes of domestic violence. Upon writing of this annual report, Fresno Police Department reported that domestic violence is the ONLY violent crime to increase so far this year, up 22%. Sadly, our community has held the rank of having the highest per capita calls to law enforcement for domestic violence in the State. Domestic violence will only rise to a level that a community is willing to accept. We all have a responsibility to do better.

Thank you for your investment in the Marjaree Mason Center. Your courage, and philanthropic support, provides a safe refuge when a person has nowhere else to turn. You are truly saving lives. We couldn't be more thankful for your partnership and life-saving investment.

KNOW MORE

PREVENTING AND ENDING DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Throughout the year, 26 Fresno County high schools hosted the kNOW MORE Teen Dating Violence Prevention program on their campuses. Students, faculty, and staff share information about healthy vs. unhealthy relationships, red flags, how to help a friend, and how to create change on their campuses, in their homes and in their own relationships.

In December 2021, Marjaree Mason Center's received a \$375,000 grant from Anthem Blue Cross Foundation to launch a program that would bring community partners together for wrap-around medical services for expectant mothers who had experienced domestic violence, to complement the care they were already receiving from the Center. The 2-year Maternal Health Program was launched in partnership with UCSF Fresno and the County of Fresno, Department of Public Health offering trauma-informed medical care, individualized case management, and empowering services, to address a survivors' physical, emotional, and practical needs.

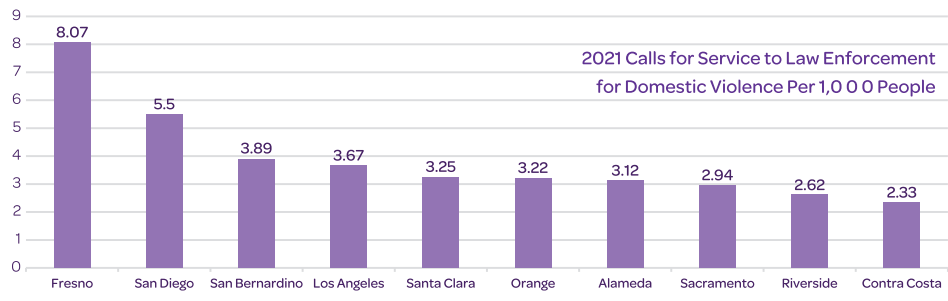
