Under Nicole's leadership, MMC has seen significant growth and impact, expanding its reach, strengthening its programs, and elevating its role as a leading service provider in the community. The Board of Directors is committed to honoring her accomplishments while moving forward with a careful and inclusive process to identify the organization's next leader.
